Qualifying nominations will receive applications for funding to be returned and evaluated over the summer. The total list of applications will be narrowed to six (6) by a vote of the Philanthropy Committee, which consists of the Board of Directors and Officers. The names of the six (6) philanthropies will be announced at the September General Meeting and all Active and Voting Associate members will be able to vote for not more than three (3) philanthropies at the October General Meeting. The three (3) chosen philanthropies will receive the majority of the funds raised during the year. All other nominated charities will be eligible for funds as decided during the June Philanthropy Disbursement Meeting (time and location will be announced in the roster). All members are invited to attend although voting remains the responsibility of the Philanthropy Committee.
