**Philanthropy** is beginning 2023 with much excitement, enthusiasm, and anticipation for all that we will be able to do for our charities this year, thanks to our amazing members and phenomenal fund-raising efforts so far. In November, we were happy to welcome David Bader from the Marine Mammal Care Center. His talk and slide presentation were extremely informative and thought-provoking, encouraging each of us to find ways that we can do more to protect our environment. Thank you to all who donated bleach and gift cards. MMCC was very grateful.

Our January General Meeting will feature speakers from two more of our charities, Tena Yatroussis from Momentum Pediatric Therapy Network and Cathy Caesar from Toberman Neighborhood Center. Each of them has sent us a quick update on what's happening with their groups, in addition to their requests for inkind donations that you may bring to our meeting.

In July of 2021, Pediatric Therapy Network merged with Momentum to become Momentum Pediatric Therapy Network (MPTN). Now MPTN provides the same exceptional early interventions and therapies for infants through age 14 that "PTN" has been providing for years. Over the last year we moved confidently into the post-COVID healthcare landscape restoring all our programs and services to take place in person.

- Leaps and Bounds Early Intervention for 18 to 36 months at risk or with development disabilities.
- Early Start Denver Model for small group intervention for 12 to 36 months with a diagnosis or at risk for autism.
- Buddy Club for 4 to 12 years old with disabilities to develop social skills.
- Early Head Start pre-pre-school program for children who live beneath the poverty line.
- AAC Augmentative Assisted Communication programs for non-verbal children.
- The Feeding Clinic for children with sensory issues and developmental delays that impair their nutrition.
- And of course, Camp Escapades offering the complete summer camp experience for children ages 5 to 14 years with disabilities and medical conditions.

We remain extremely grateful to Las Candalistas for empowering Momentum Pediatric Therapy Network to transform the lives of children and their families regardless of their challenges.

Momentum has been collecting and distributing gifts in their community through the Holiday Season and will continue to collect gifts in January to prepare for their Share the Love season in February. Please check out this link for their in-kind donation requests.

**Toberman Neighborhood Center** (TNC) continues to welcome children, youth, and families by offering programs to improve the quality of life towards building a safe and healthy community. TNC currently serves 10,000+ individuals and families a year who reside in greater Los Angeles, with a focus on the Harbor areas of San Pedro, Wilmington, Harbor City, Harbor Gateway and Long Beach. We focus on 4 specific program areas including Youth Development (our afterschool program as well as our

College Corner), Gang Prevention and Intervention programs (working with 10-15 year old's and 16-24 year old's respectively, providing resources and supports to children and young adults to either keep them out of gangs or help get them out of gangs) and our Family Source Center (providing one-on-one case management and access to basic needs through the Toberman food pantry and thrift store). We pride ourselves as being the beacon of hope those in our community. As we approach the new year, we look forward to our "I Have a Dream" event as well as a ribbon cutting ceremony in the spring for our new playground!

Toberman is requesting in-kind donations of Peanut butter, jelly, sugar, flour, pastas (rice, spaghetti, etc.), cooking oil, Cup of Noodles/Top Ramen, pop open canned foods (fruit, spam, soup, spaghetti, etc.), canned foods (veggies, beans, tuna, etc.), juice, milk, crackers, instant oatmeal, regular oatmeal, cereals, dairy foods, diapers, and baby formula.

#### **Email Marketing (Constant Contact):**

We have been using Constant Contact for email marketing for several years. I wanted to explain what this is, for those of you who are not familiar with it.

Constant Contact is an email marketing company that will send out emails for your organization. They have professional templates and the ability to send mass emails. If you subscribe to receive emails from your favorite stores, you have most likely received emails via Constant Contact.

We utilize Constant Contact mostly to advertise our events. In fact, our most recent fundraising event, 'A Night at the Ranch,' used Constant Contact as the primary advertising source (along with a follow-up postcard)

All LC members are on the Constant Contact email list so any time one is sent out, you will receive it. You can, in turn, forward it on to friends, which helps us spread the word.

However, often times emails sent through companies like Constant Contact can wind up in your Promotions box or Spam box rather than your Primary inbox. So please check all your inboxes to make sure you haven't missed an email. You can all add <a href="mailto:lascandalistas@gmail.com">lascandalistas@gmail.com</a> to your contact list. That will help.
